The 2021-22 tax request for interest on bonds is \$219,280 which is .2250589 cents for \$100 assessed value. The 2020-21 tax request for interest on bonds was \$150,000 which was .1782049 cents for \$100 assessed value.

Mayor Preister presented the current year disbursements.

Mayor Preister discussed with the council the 1% allowable increase.

Mayor Preister asked for comments from the public. Patrick Murphy of the Humphrey Democrat was the only person present at the meeting besides the Council.
